

SHUTTERBOX SEEDER DIRECTIONS FOR USE

The pilot holes in the sliders will need to be drilled out to the size of your seed (or the size of multiple seeds, if you desire to seed more than one seed at a time). Use a good quality drill bit used for drilling into metal. Place slider on a solid piece of wood for support and drill through the pilot holes into the wood.

First place the slider into the seeder. With the slider completely against the side (closed position), place seed into the trough next to you. Spread the seed evenly though out the trough.

While holding the slider in the closed position tilt the seeder away from you causing the seed to flow out of the trough and across the slider. Tilt the seeder in several directions to finally locate a seed into every hole in the slider.

Next tilt the seeder back toward you to slide all excess seed back into the trough.

Finally set the seeder on top of the tray and align it to the two sides of the seeder. Then pull open the slider to align with the larger bottom holes. Next tap the slider to cause the seed to release and fall through the large stationary bottom holes into the cavities or cells of the tray.
